## Monthly HBCU Prayer Target: *Xavier University of Louisiana*

Xavier University of Louisiana is a private institution that was founded in 1915. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 2,504. It is the nation's only Black and Catholic University. Xavier sends more African-Americans into medical school than any other college.

Deanna Ceasar has been reaching out to Xavier students for over four years now. Please pray for Deanna for open doors with the administration (Chi Alpha needs official recognition by the university), for staff help, and for a property across from campus to use as ministry center. All of these need serious and fervent intercession.
